

Wamego Recreation Department 2016 Tee Ball Rules

1. Game will last 1 hour.
2. All players bat each inning. Offensive coaches should be at 1st and 3rd base areas.
3. All players play the field at the same time. No more than 3 defensive coaches should be in the field to direct the defenders.
4. All fielders must wear a glove.
5. An offensive coach may make two pitches to the batters from the 35' rubber. If the batter does not hit one of the two pitches, the ball will be placed on the batting tee.
6. The catcher must be in the catcher's circle behind the batter before the ball is hit.
7. All batters and catchers must wear a helmet.
8. Runners may advance one base on each hit. If the ball is hit into the grass, the runners may advance until the ball is back in the infield.
9. A ball must be hit past the arc in front of home plate to be considered a fair ball.
10. The last batter of every inning may advance as far as possible. The offense must tell the defense when the last batter is up to bat.
11. All games will be played at the South Diamonds (by Wamego City Park).
12. In the event of possible game cancellation due to weather, illness, etc. parents should call their child's coach.
13. Coaches should check rec.wamego.org, or contact our cancellation line at **785-456-1666**. We will update both of these if delays or cancellations occur. When calling the event cancellation line, you will hear a recorded message. If games are canceled, the message will include the current date. If an old message is on the line, games are still on as scheduled.
