

Ordinance No. 1802

AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, AMENDING ARTICLE 2 LOCAL OFFENSES, OF CHAPTER XI PUBLIC OFFENSES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, IN RELATION TO THE CURFEW OF MINORS; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS:

Section 1. Article 2. Local Offenses of Chapter XI. Public Offenses, be and the same is hereby amended by addition of two new paragraphs to read as follows:

11-203 Curfew Hours are 12:01am through 5:00 am Monday through Friday, and 1:00 a.m. though 5:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

It shall be unlawful for a minor, any person under 18 years of age, during curfew hours to be on or in any public place within the city, to remain in any motor vehicle operating or parked, or to remain in or upon the premises of any establishment with the city, unless the minor is accompanied by a legal guardian or involved in a work, school sponsored, religious, civic or public organization or agency actively supervised by adults.

11-204 Same; Penalty.

Any minor violating "curfew hours" or legal guardian will be subject to a twenty-five-dollar (\$25) fine for the first offense, fifty-dollar (\$50) fine for the second offense and one-hundred-dollar (\$100) fine for the third and subsequent offenses plus court costs.

Section 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in from and after its passage and publication in the City's official paper, The Times, Pottawatomie County.

The above and foregoing Ordinance passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Wamego, Kansas, this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 2024.
