

Ordinance No. 1832

AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, ADDING SECTION 11-205 and 11-206 TO ARTICLE 2 LOCAL REGULATIONS, OF CHAPTER XI PUBLIC OFFENSES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR SPECIAL EVENT TO INCLUDE BUT NOT LIMITED TO BLOCK PARTIES, CLOSING OF STREETS, ORGANIZED WALKS OR RUNS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS:

Section 1. Article 2, 11-205. All requests to close or use public property for organized events shall require an application for a permit a minimum of 30 days prior to the event to be approved by the City Manager or designee. All applications will require a drawing of the location with a written plan. All walking or running events must adhere to the city approved route. All other routes must meet the approval of the city designated route specialist prior to the approval of the application. If approved, the City of Wamego shall supply equipment to close the street or public property by the organizer of the event. The closing and opening of the public space shall be the responsibility of the organizer of the event.

Section 2. Article 2, 11-206. Any person violating the provisions of § 11-205 shall be subject to a fine of \$500 per occurrence.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in from and after its passage and publication in the City's official paper, The Times, Pottawatomie County.
