The City of Wamego will take one week in November to pick up your bagged leaves and clippings at the front curb. Tree limbs should be tied in 3' X 3' bundles in different sections of Wamego. See the schedule below to know when they'll be in your neighborhood.

Monday, November 13th - All areas East of Lincoln Ave.

Tuesday, November 14th - All areas West of Lincoln Ave, East of Walnut, and South of 8th.

Wednesday, November 15th - All areas West of Lincoln Ave and North of 8th.

Thursday, November 16th - All areas West of Walnut and South of 8th.

Friday, November 17th-Miscellaneous pick-ups

## STREET PROJECT

The street project is going well! Vine is now completely underway and moving on schedule. The updated timeline has Chestnut demolition from 4th-6th scheduled in January of 2024 and from 6th-8th being demolished in February.

If Vine stays on schedule we are hopeful for completion in May of 2024 and Chestnut to be completed in September of 2024.
