### Outdoor Pool Hours:

- Weekdays: 1:00–6:00 PM & 7:00–9:00 PM
- Weekends: 1:00–6:00 PM

### Outdoor Pool Pricing:

- Daily Admission: \$5
- Season Pass: \$60
- 10-Punch Pass: \$40



### Outdoor Water Fitness

- Water Aerobics (M–F, 12:00–12:45 PM)
  - Season Pass: \$100 | Drop-In: \$5
- Unguided Water Walking (M–F, 6:00–6:45 PM)
  - Season Pass: \$75 | Drop-In: \$5



## DON'T FORGET—THE INDOOR POOL IS OPEN YEAR-ROUND!

Perfect for lap swimmers, early risers, or those rainy summer days, our indoor pool is open Monday–Thursday, 6:00AM–8:00PM with breaks at 8AM and 5AM for water aerobic classes, and Friday–Sunday from 12:00PM–8:00PM.

### Indoor Pool Pricing:

- Daily Admission: \$4
- Monthly Membership: \$30
  - This includes Water Aerobics
- Water Aerobics Drop-In: \$4

## UTV REQUIREMENTS

Golf carts, micro utility trucks, and work-site utility vehicles are special-purpose vehicles that must be registered with the City of Wamego if operated on City streets. Operators must possess a valid driver's license and have liability insurance coverage for their vehicles. The registration fee is \$25 regardless of when the application is made and tags can be picked up at City Hall. Call 785-456-9119 if you have questions on what type of transportation needs to be registered or is allowed on City streets.

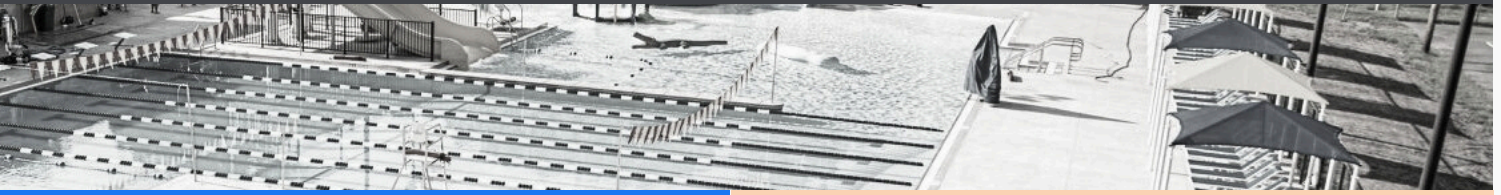

## ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING PORTS NEEDS INSPECTED!

IF YOU OWN AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE, REMEMBER THAT A DEDICATED CIRCUIT FOR YOUR CHARGING OUTLET IS A MUST! WHEN EV CHARGING STATIONS ARE INCORRECTLY INSTALLED, THE RISK OF EXPLOSION OR FIRE IS GREATLY INCREASED FOR LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES. CITY INSPECTION IS REQUIRED TO ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE A SAFE CHARGING STATION IN PLACE. CONTACT THE CITY OF WAMEGO AT (785) 456-9119 TO INQUIRE ABOUT AN ELECTRIC PERMIT. REMEMBER THAT ONLY A PROPERTY OWNER OR CITY LICENSED ELECTRICIAN MAY CONDUCT AN ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION!



## NEW HOURS FOR THE CHILDREN'S TRAIN IN CITY PARK

All aboard! The Children's Train in City Park is back for the season! We've got new hours this year, so make sure to plan your visit:

Tuesdays, Thursdays,  
and Saturdays  
9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

This ride is just for kids! Riders must be at least 36 inches tall unless accompanied by a co-rider who meets the height requirement.

It runs mid-April through October, weather permitting. It won't run during rain or when temps are above 95°F.

## TREE PLANTING TIPS!

### FIND THE PERFECT SPOT!



- Be sure to pick a place where the ground is flat and there is a lot of sun
- Avoid a spot with electric wires above or pipes below
- Stay 35' away from intersection corners and 10' away from fire hydrants
- Do not plant your tree in the city's right-of-way or on city property

### PREPARE FOR PLANTING!



- Water the area before you start digging
- Your hole should be 3X wider than the root ball and the same depth as roots

### TAKING CARE OF YOUR TREE



- Make sure the trunk of the tree does not have extra dirt or mulch against it
- For the first 2 years, water your tree regularly
- Add mulch before summer or freezing temperatures
- Prune your tree every 2-3 months

### LAWN CARE REMINDER

- GRASS MUST BE KEPT UNDER 6", WEEDS UNDER 12"
- NO GRASS CLIPPINGS IN THE STREET—THEY'RE DANGEROUS FOR BIKERS AND CLOG STORM DRAINS!
- TAKE CLIPPINGS, LIMBS, AND BRUSH TO THE DUMP SITE ON VALLEY STREET (SOUTH OF THE WASTEWATER PLANT).



### BACKYARD POOL SEASON

POOLS OVER 24" DEEP NEED SAFETY FEATURES LIKE FENCES, SELF-LATCHING GATES, AND ALARMS FOR HOUSE ACCESS. PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED—CALL BEFORE YOU INSTALL!
