**The Wamego Recreation Department's basketball program serves athletes in 1st–6th grade, offering separate leagues by age group and gender. The season features a 6-game schedule, with 1st/2nd grade teams playing on Sunday afternoons and 3rd–6th grade teams competing on Saturday mornings.**

**The program focuses on skill development, fundamentals, and structured gameplay appropriate for each age level. Athletes gain experience working as part of a team, building confidence on the court, and learning the rules of the game in a supportive, recreational setting.**

# LEW SCHUMACHER FISHING CLINIC

---

The Lew Schumacher Annual Youth Fishing Clinic provides a hands-on introduction to fishing for youth ages 6–18. The event begins with an educational session covering basic skills, safe practices, and an overview of the equipment. After the instructional portion, participants have the opportunity to apply what they've learned by fishing in the Wamego City Park Pond.

Held alongside Community Day in the Park, this year's clinic drew strong interest from both registered participants and walk-ups. The first 100 youth who had not previously attended were eligible to receive a free fishing pole.

**The Wamego Recreation Department offers spring and fall soccer leagues for athletes in PreK through 5th grade. Each season includes a six-week schedule with games held on Saturday mornings. Spring play begins in March, while fall sessions begin in September.**

Challenger provides coaching staff and age-specific sessions for athletes ranging from preschool to high school. ---

The Wamego Recreation Department offers summer baseball, softball, and T-Ball programs for ages 5–14, with all leagues beginning in May. Age groups progress from machine pitch (7–8) to kid pitch (9–11 and 12–14), providing athletes with consistent game experience and development in core skills such as throwing, hitting, and fielding.

For younger players, the Lil Tykes T-Ball Clinic gives children ages 3–5 an introductory experience before entering league play. This program focuses on basic fundamentals. It serves as a fun, age-appropriate first step into the summer ball programs.

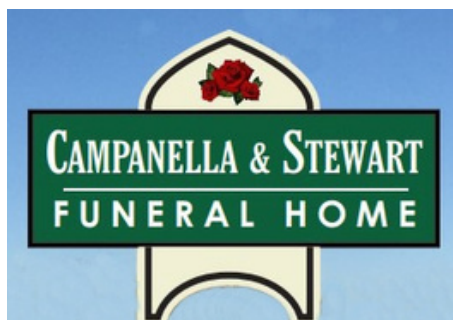
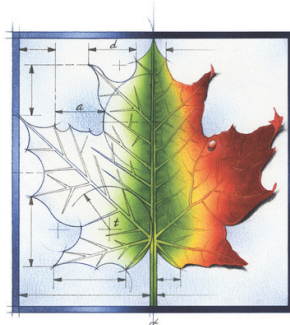
# **FLAG FOOTBALL**
